#### **Approval of April 19 Minutes**

Minutes were approved with two corrections (Senior Design & the team who prepared the 2010-2011 slate of the Board of Directors)

#### Yarnall Award Wrapup

- Harris shared that Dr. Crothall was very honored to receive the Yarnall award this year.
- There were issues with the sound quality and seating in the Hall of Flags. The sound issues were later resolved.
- Dean Glandt intends to improve the overall Senior Awards Ceremony and Yarnall Award presentation going forward.



#### **Senior Design Competition**

- Walt shared that there were originally 46 judges registered to participate in the competition.
- Scores were received and processed for 38 judges on that date.
- The scores were exceptionally close for the first place and honorable mention awards. The quality of the presentations is making it increasingly difficult to delineate between the winners.
- Thank you to Janice for preparing the packets with the abstracts.
- Eric shared that Digital Media Design may be listed as a separate major starting in the Fall of 2010. Additionally, Computer Engineering and Computer Science Engineering will be separate majors.
- The student run videos of the competition were accepted.

#### **Development Office Report**

- The fiscal year end is 6/30.
- The goal was \$10MM and Engineering may hit \$11MM for the year. While it was a below average year, the prospects are getting better.
- Annual giving is up in donors and dollars and the Engineering school ranks among the top of the university for donors and dollars.
- There are currently 5 people prepared to participate in the million dollar campaign in India.
