C. EAS Website Analytics Data (J. Ng)

- Slides were presented by Jeffrey on Penn EAS Website – Google Analytics Analysis
- A drop-off in visitor/user traffic since this time last year was observed
- Data presented was measured from the time the new website went live
- Various metrics were presented:
 - Avg. 100-200 visitors per month
- Perhaps launching new website and new updates was cause for greater traffic last year
- Avg. session duration and pages per session were analyzed as well and appeared to increase this year
 - A “session” is evaluated using cookies for both new and returning visitors
- Geographic distribution information on visitors (both national and international) was presented
- Technological Breakdown slide presented the types of browsers and devices used to access the website
- User flow through various pages on website was shown as well
 - After the Homepage, the following were the most visited pages by users:
 - (1) About
 - (2) Engaging Alumni Page
 - (3) Events Calendar
 - (4) Alumni Events
 - (5) Alumni Mentoring Program
- Committees should look at the website as a tool
- Seville:
 - Is information checked periodically to ensure it's correct and up-to-date?

- (1) Jeffrey - Yes, Brad does check it, but there are ways to keep it updated better
 - Is it possible to have a social media feed on the page?
 - (1) Jeffrey - No, Facebook API issue prevents it, but perhaps we can have a highlight section on the webpage to draw focus to the social media pages
 - Pages can be streamed, but not groups
 - (1) Jeffrey will revisit
 - Matt
 - There should be at least one single piece of info that we update on the homepage to get visitors engaged. i.e. link to next meeting, major upcoming event, etc.
 - Photo archive could/should be paired with a blog post from each event with pictures so it ties-in better with social media

 - “How to design, build, and launch consumer grade products” topic was presented
