 - Slides were presented by Jeffrey on Penn EAS Website Google Analytics Analysis
 - A drop-off in visitor/user traffic since this time last year was observed
 - Data presented was measured from the time the new website when live
 - Various metrics were presented:
 - Avg. 100-200 visitors per month
 - Perhaps launching new website and new updates was cause for greater traffic last year
 - Avg. session duration and pages per session were analyzed as well and appeared to increase this year
 - A "session" is evaluated using cookies for both new and returning visitors
 - Geographic distribution information on visitors (both national and international) was presented
 - Technological Breakdown slide presented the types of browsers and devices used to access the website
 - User flow through various pages on website was shown as well
 - After the Homepage, the following were the most visited pages by users:

 - (3) Events Calendar

 - Committees should look at the website as a tool
